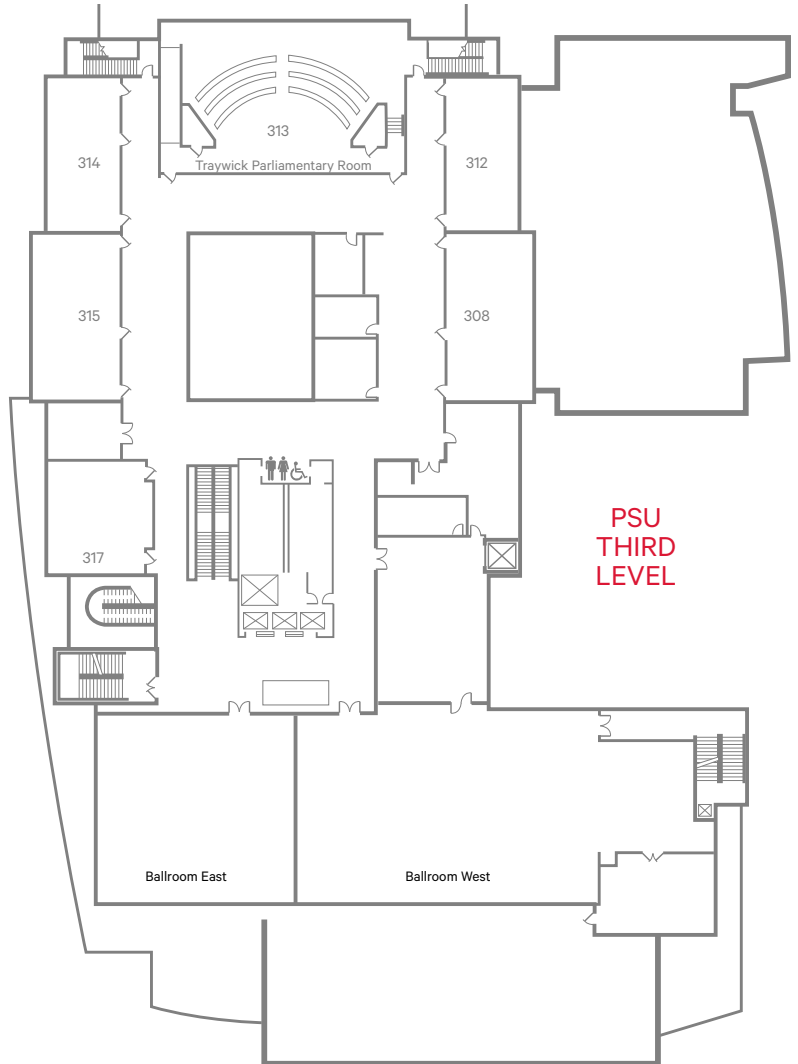
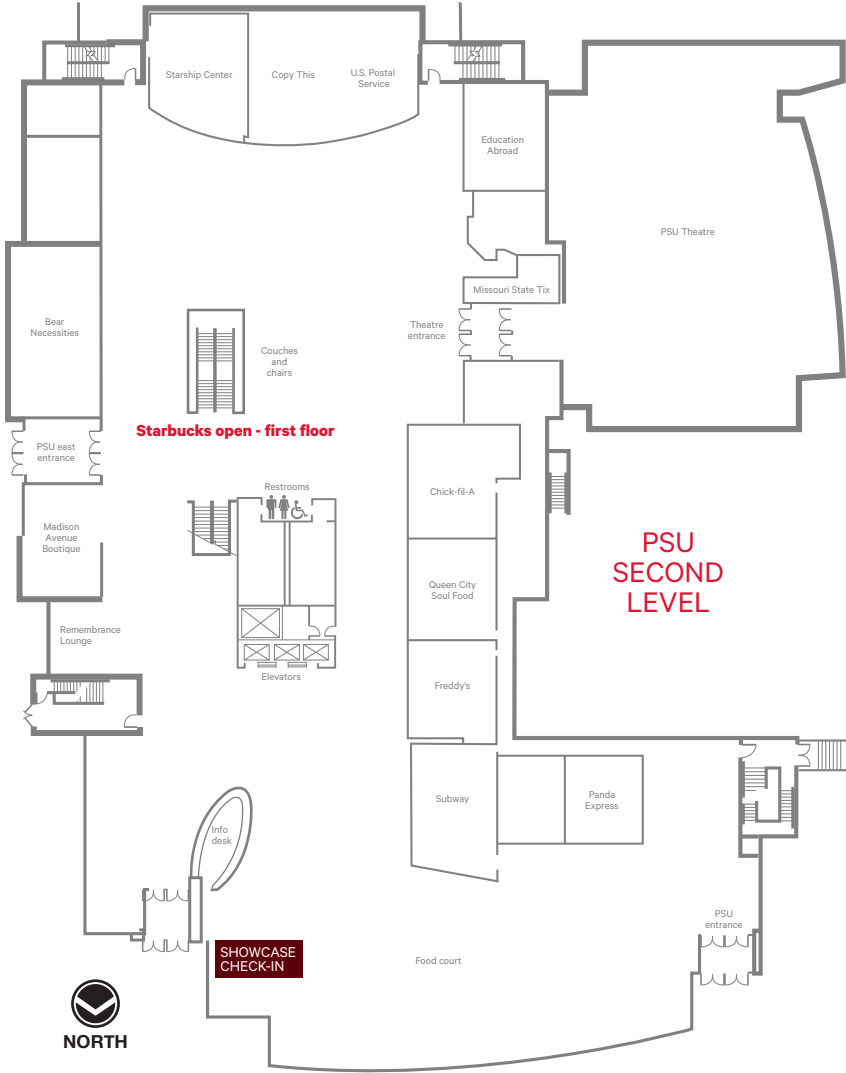
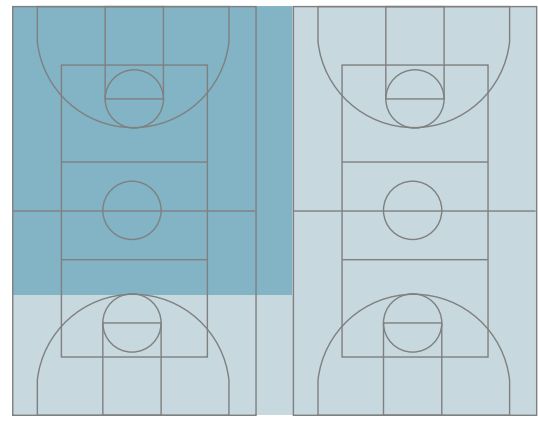
**Brick City art and design facilities**

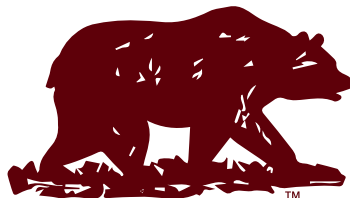
