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
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

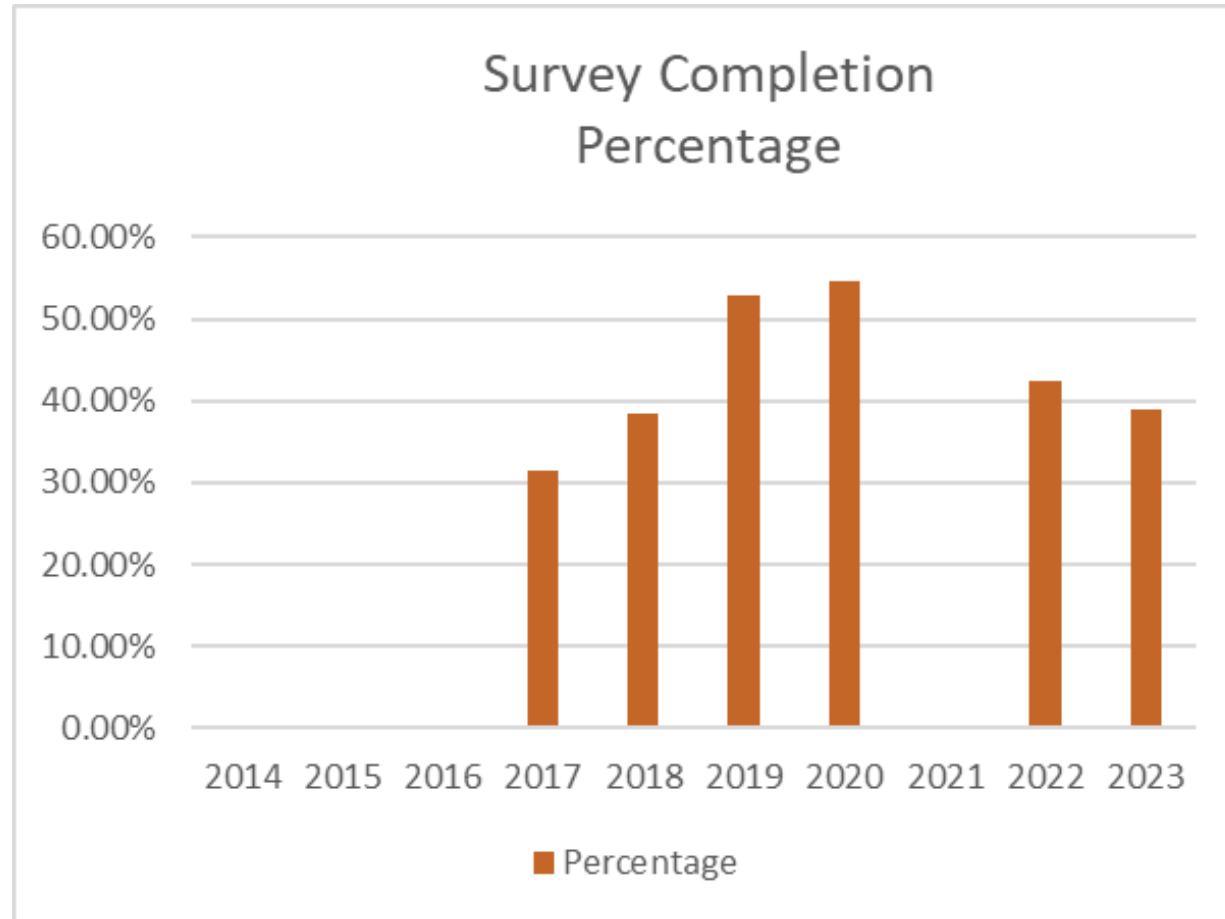


Five-year completion rate of current exit surveys

Items Chosen for Action



Establish a benchmark for completion rates in the School of Nursing Evaluation Plan



Revise MSN Exit Survey



Revise DNP Exit Survey



Follow-up Plans & Next Steps



Set benchmark for survey completion rates



Modify Qualtrics to reflect changes to the survey



Disseminate to School of Nursing and relevant stakeholders



Implement for May 2024 cohort graduates (survey to be sent August 2024)



Use exit survey results for potential program revisions



Items that Need Action at Higher Levels than the Department



Summary of the revision process to be included in the Continuous Improvement Program Report due to CCNE in December 2024



CCNE to review revised surveys at the next accreditation visit in 2027
