Two 16-bed coed residential treatment facilities located in Nixa, Missouri. Bramblewood (for ages 8-12) and Milano House (for ages 12-17). The clients have severe emotional disturbances, or who have suffered physical, emotional, and/or sexual abuse. The clients, due to behavior, may not be contained in a less restrictive setting.

Description of practicum students' duties at your site:

Work with clients on basic coping skills in the facility, and participate in recreational activities with clients, assist with schoolwork, and general treatment plan goals.

Type of population with which students would be working (e.g., adults, adolescents, children, physically challenged, cognitively challenged, etc.):

Emotionally and behaviorally challenged clients ages 8-17.

#### **Our Students**

#### **Undergraduates**

Our undergraduate students typically are juniors and seniors with 17-35 credit hours in Psychology. There are exceptions. If you have any special

requirements for students who apply at your practicum site, please describe them.

Good to excellent emotional and physical boundaries are a must. Need to be a team player with the capacity to help staff. Requires a background screening through the Missouri Department of Health and Senior Services Family Care Safety Registry.

#### **Graduate Students**

Our graduate students are students at the end of their first year or some time during their second year in the clinical track of our graduate psychology program. These students need direct service contact with clients, and also need weekly supervision from a licensed mental health professional. Is your site interested in working with our graduate students?

It is unlikely we can provide the needed experience for your students; but this may be revisited at a later time.

Our facilities are 24/7, but practicum hours would be available on a weekday basis from late afternoon or early evening to allow for client school attendance. Weekend hours may also be an option.
