### **Your Site**

## Description of the activities that occur at your site:

 We give the students the opportunity to experience the multiple functions of Human Resources including but not limited to recruitment, operations, compensation, data integrity, worker's compensation, benefits, employee relations, and employee health. Therefore, the activities are a combination of shadowing and actual tasks in each area. If the student has a larger interest in one area we will try to expand their experience within that specific area.

### Description of practicum students' duties at your site:

- Shadowing a variety of HR professionals and content experts.
- We do have scanning and other clerical duties that a student may assist with but we make sure to show the student how those things fit into the larger picture showing their importance.
- We have projects that require critical thinking and great communication skills.
   They vary by time of the year and what is going on.
  - o Below are some of the projects our last intern worked on:
    - Aggregated both quantitative and qualitative data for exit interviews. We are switching to a vendor for this function but had a year's worth of data that we needed to get from a raw data form to a presentable form. Once complete we worked with the student to utilize critical thinking for the implications of the results. This gave the student insight to the multiple factors that impact separations.
    - Prepared a program that Mercy does for our co-workers involving adopting Christmas families. This included coordination with not for profit agencies in the Ozarks to ensure the greatest good is being

met. This gave the student experience with the ethical principle of distributive justice.

Type of population with which students would be working (e.g., adults, adolescents, children, physically challenged, cognitively challenged, etc.):

 Primarily adults but being in a healthcare facility there could be interaction with any of those listed.

## **Undergraduates**
