Student Has a Conduct Meeting

- STUDENT RESPONDS TO THE POLICY VIOLATION.
- STUDENT MAY BRING AN ADVISOR IF THEY WISH.
- IF THE STUDENT DOES NOT ATTEND MEETING, IT IS HELD IN THEIR ABSENCE.
