No course may be used to satisfy more than one requirement within the Digital Film and Television Production major. Students majoring in Digital Film and Television Production cannot complete a minor in Mass Media. They may select, as an optional minor, Film Studies, Journalism, Screenwriting or any other BS minor.
